

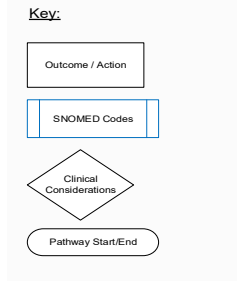
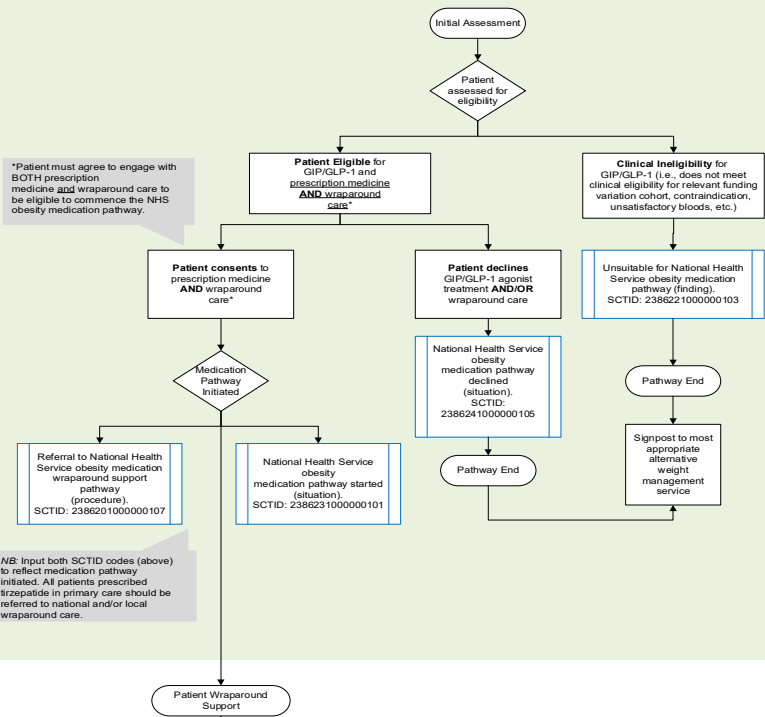
SNOMED CT Codes for NHS Obesity Medication Pathway (Tirzepatide in Primary Care)

Initial Assessment SNOMED codes should be used following an initial assessment for access to tirzepatide (Mounjaro). These codes are for primary care and should not be used for patients prescribed other medicines in specialist weight management services.

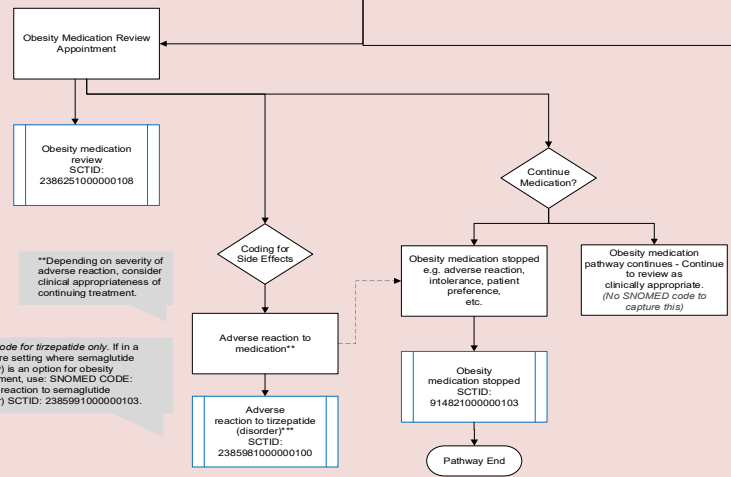
Clinical Support - Medication Review Appointments SNOMED codes should be used after tirzepatide has been prescribed and the appropriate clinician undertakes a medicine review appointment. The codes may be used to record an obesity medication review, adverse reaction(s), and/or deprescribing.

Behavioural Support for Obesity Prescribing (BSOP) SNOMED codes should be used when tirzepatide has been prescribed, and the patient has commenced BSOP, used to record completion status. Referral to BSOP should be coded when the medicine pathway is initiated following Initial Assessment.
